

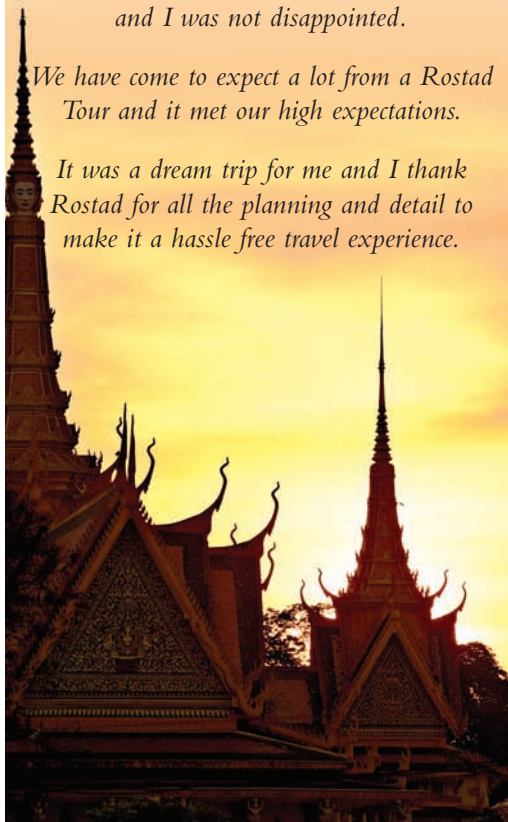
Cambodia & Vietnam

If you would like to receive a detailed brochure via mail, click this icon and it will be added to your wish list.



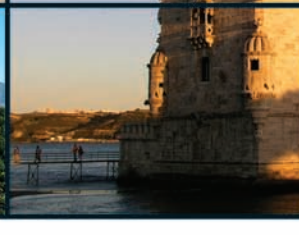
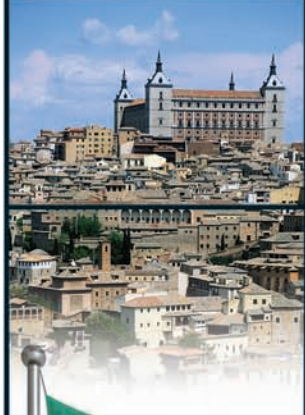
Once you are finished selecting which tour brochures you would like to receive by mail, click on this icon so you can give us your name and the address where we should send the brochure.

NOW IS THE TIME TO VISIT THE HOLY LAND

There are few life experiences that can affect a person as much as a journey to the roots of their faith. Christian pilgrims have been visiting the Holy Land for hundreds of years in search of spiritual enlightenment. Over the past thirty years Rostad Tours has made it possible for thousands of Christians to visit the birthplace of our Saviour. Many have returned for a second or third time as there is so much to see it is impossible to absorb everything in one visit.

Is now a good time to consider a trip to the Holy Land? Consider this:

- Prices are reasonable due to the strength of the Canadian Dollar
- The decline in travel by American groups due to the recession means hotels are keen to attract business from other countries
- It's best to avoid the Easter period which is in late April next year, making it ideal to travel in February and March and escape our winter
- Travel to Israel from Canada set a record in March this year, increasing 24% over last year and 9% higher than the previous record set in 2000

We have several itineraries to choose from:

Journey through the Holy Land Israel

Certainly the spiritual highlight of any journey to the Holy Land, a tour that only visits Israel allows pilgrims to focus on all the biblical sites concentrated in this area. Considering Israel's small size (barely 50 miles at its widest point) there are an amazing number of places to visit.

Our tours usually start by travelling to Galilee – where Jesus spent His childhood and later became the centre of His ministry. Staying here for a few days provides the opportunity to visit Nazareth, Capernaum, the Mount of Beatitudes, Caesarea Philippi, the Jordan River and take a boat trip across the Sea of Galilee.

Next is a day in the Judean Wilderness to see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found, ride a cable-car up Masada to admire the view while exploring Herod's fortress and visit a spa where you can float in the Dead Sea.

The tour finishes in and around Jerusalem – a spiritual city that is tremendously significant

to three faiths. Visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem and see the nearby Shepherd's Fields. In Jerusalem, walk down the Mount of Olives and visit the Garden of Gethsemane. Explore the Old City, see the Western Wall and nearby Dome of the Rock. Walk along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Visit the inspirational Garden Tomb and take part in a private communion service.

Holy Land Experience Israel + Jordan

Besides all the sites in Israel, this tour ventures across the Jordan River to visit a number of important places mentioned in the Bible. Highlights include Mount Nebo – where Moses stood overlooking the Promised Land; Bethany-beyond-the-Jordan – where many believe John conducted baptisms; and Petra – the magnificent "rose-red" city that remained a secret for centuries. Other sites include Kerak – a crusader castle; Wadi-Rum – where Lawrence of Arabia called home; and Jerash – to see the fabulous ruins of a well-preserved Greco-Roman city referred to in the Bible as Gerasa.

Walking Through History

Israel + Egypt

These two countries have been intricately linked through the ages and the ancient land of the pharaohs has attracted visitors for thousands of years. The awe-inspiring pyramids and sphinx still mystify both tourists and archaeologists today. The Egyptian Museum in Cairo boasts a superb collection of antiquities, including the fabulous treasures excavated from the tomb

of Tutankhamen. In the Sinai, stay at the guesthouse next to the historic Saint Catherine's Monastery and have the opportunity to climb Mount Moses. You can also visit southern Egypt to explore the tombs of the pharaohs at the Valley of the Kings and wander through Karnak Temple – the largest place of worship ever constructed.

Lands of the Bible

Egypt + Jordan + Israel

This tour is a unique combination of these three neighbouring countries, starting in Egypt and following the Path of the Exodus through the Sinai into Jordan. The tour then crosses the Jordan River to visit Galilee and culminates in Jerusalem. This nineteen-day tour has been our most popular itinerary over the past five years and provides an in-depth study of the region.

New Policies for 2011

In an effort to improve the quality of the experience for our clients, we are implementing two policy changes starting with our tours in 2011. We are confident these will be welcomed by our clients as there shouldn't be any unpleasant surprises on their final invoice. Our staff will also be pleased because we have always prided ourselves on the all-inclusive nature of our tours and these fees have prevented us from living up to our own ideals.

Now included – Airline Fuel Surcharges

We have become increasingly frustrated with the additional surcharges levied by airlines and particularly do not enjoy having to explain them to our clients. Many airline fees and taxes are fairly constant, but fuel surcharges change frequently and vary depending on the flight routing. Starting in 2011,

we are going to include a fuel surcharge budget for each tour, with the amount varying depending on the departure city. A supplement will only be added to the final invoice if there is a significant change in the amount of the surcharge.

Now included – Airport Improvement Fees

These were introduced as a measure to help fund construction at airports across Canada. Vancouver started it, Toronto followed suit and eventually most airports fell in line with the cash grab. The amounts have slowly increased over the years but these "temporary" fees have not disappeared, supposedly because airports must finance the cost of their improvements and then pay off these costs over an extended period of time. Starting in 2011, we are going to budget for these in the price of every tour.



This past March we were recognized by Viking River Cruises as one of their “Platinum Circle” agencies due to our strong sales record. In fact, we send more groups with Viking River Cruises than any other single agency. We have been working with them since 1998 and this mode of travel has become a very important segment of our repertoire. Viking River Cruises operates the largest and best fleet in the industry and their motto is “If you like ocean cruising, you will love river cruising.”

It’s easy to see why. Their intimate ships, averaging less than 200 passengers, take

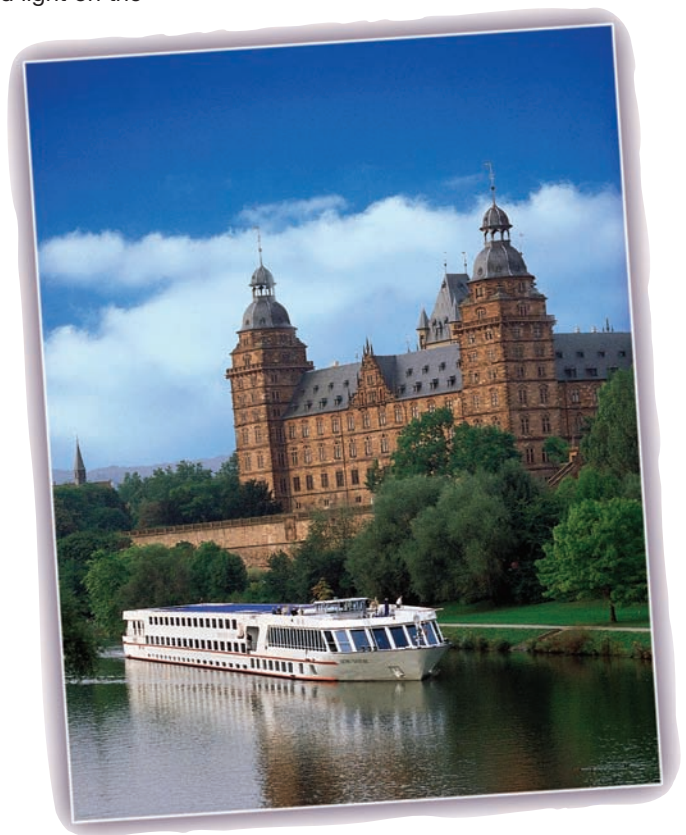
